Nomination Form

The Johnny A. Robinson, Jr., Award is the highest honor awarded through the YTCA to a person or persons for outstanding service to the YTCA or an affiliated Yorkie club, or for advancement of or other meritorious accomplishments affecting or relating to the Yorkshire Terrier breed. This award is not meant to be a "lifetime achievement" award but rather a recognition of an individual's or group of individual's club participation and/or contribution to the YTCA or one of its affiliated Yorkie clubs or to the breed. Nominations are open to a majority vote of the Board of Directors of the YTCA or of an affiliated Yorkie club, or by direct nomination by (5) YTCA members in good standing. A nominee need not be a member of the YTCA or an affiliated Yorkie club. Nominations will close each December 31st, although the award may not be given each year. The person or persons chosen by the majority vote of the YTCA Board of Directors will be presented with the award at a place and time deemed appropriate by the YTCA Board of Directors.
